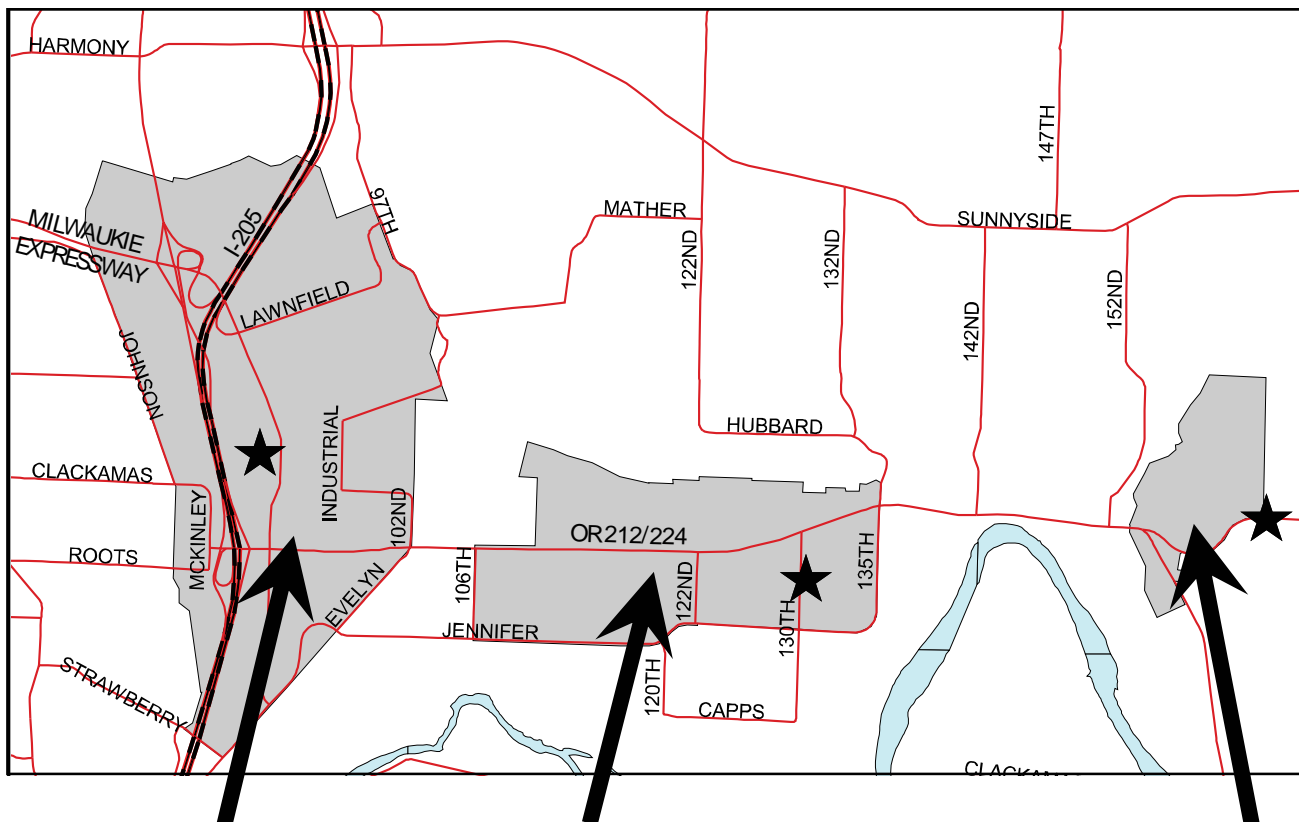




Interchange Area Management Plan (IAMP) Open Houses

Please attend the meeting for the area that is of interest to you. These meetings will be specific to the separate interchange study areas shaded below. As part of the Sunrise Project process, the Oregon Department of Transportation is required to develop Interchange Area Management Plans (IAMPs) in cooperation with local governments when the state invests funds into constructing new interchanges or making significant investment in existing interchanges. The purpose of an IAMP is to protect the function of the interchange and could mean property access and local access changes. We invite you to be part of this discussion.
